<b>Accountabilities / Outcomes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supervise and lead the section, ensuring goals and deadlines are met</li> <li>• Oversee the accurate and timely processing of tax returns, ensuring at least 90% are processed within 5 working days</li> <li>• Manage the accurate and timely registration and deregistration of TIN/CT applications, ensuring compliance with policies</li> <li>• Ensure the master filing system is maintained and 95% of manual records are updated promptly</li> <li>• Conduct inspections to ensure taxpayer compliance and achieve a minimum of 20% registration cleaning annually</li> <li>• Plan and execute two stock-taking activities annually, ensuring records are accurate and discrepancies are addressed</li> <li>• Oversee the verification and timely correction of taxpayer data, ensuring accuracy in the system</li> <li>• Prepare and submit performance and compliance reports to the Deputy CEO</li> <li>• Ensure adherence to all tax laws, policies and procedures within the Tax Operations Division</li> <li>• Recommend and implement initiatives to enhance efficiency and service delivery in tax operations.</li> </ul>
