CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2023

CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT [CAP. 11.03]

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 45 of the Customs and Excise Management Act [CAP. 11.03], the Minister responsible for revenue and customs, with the approval of Cabinet, makes the following Order and as amended by the Legislative Assembly on 4th March 2024 by virtue of section 9 of the Government Act (Cap 8.06) —

1 Short Title and Interpretation

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise Management Act (Amendment) Order 2023.
- (2) The Customs and Excise Management Act Order 2007, listing prohibited and restricted imports and exports published in the Government Gazette Supplement Extraordinary No. 3 on 21 January 2008, as amended, shall be referred to as the “Principal Order”.

2 Schedule 1 Amended

Schedule 1 of the Principal Order is amended by repealing paragraph 10 and replacing it with the following new paragraph –

- “10. Vehicles principally designed for transport of persons, under tariff heading 8703 with model year equal to or more than 10 years from the

date of import. PROVIDED THAT this prohibition shall come into effect 6 months from the date this Order is confirmed by the Legislative Assembly.”.
